



Special Issue on Novel Coronavirus Vaccination ④ ～Information on the Third Dose of the Vaccine～

While vaccines are highly effective in preventing infections, it is said that the effectiveness of vaccines gradually decreases over time. In order to prevent the spread of infection and severe outcomes, please consider getting a third dose of the vaccine. In Chiba City, the third round of vaccination will also be conducted mainly through individual vaccination at your family doctor or other familiar medical institutions. In addition, mass vaccinations will be available at public facilities in the city.

1. Information on the Third Dose of the Vaccine

The third vaccination will be given to those who have passed 8 months or more from the second vaccination. In addition, the vaccination interval for some people will be shortened, and vaccinations will be administered from the following starting dates. Vaccination vouchers will be delivered by each vaccination period. You can make an appointment as soon as you receive your vaccination voucher.

(1) Vaccination start date

- ① Workers and residents of nursing homes
6 months after the second vaccination
- ② Those who will reach 65 years old or more by Thursday, March 31
7 months after the second vaccination
- ③ Those other than the above
8 months after the second vaccination

(2) Vaccination voucher delivery schedule

Eligibility	Month of the second vaccination	Scheduled shipping date
Workers at nursing homes	August 2021	Monday, February 7
Those who are/will be 65 or older	June 2021	Monday, January 17
	July1-July 30, 2021	From Monday, January 24 to Monday, February 7
Those other than the above	June 2021	Monday, January 31

Residents and employees of nursing homes can receive the vaccination at the facility where they live or work, even before receiving their vaccination voucher, as long as 6 months or more have passed since the second vaccination.

(3) How to make an appointment

- ① For those who make an appointment at their family doctor (*Kakaritsuke*)

Please follow the reservation procedures of each medical institution.

- ② For those who make a reservation at a clinic that accepts anyone (*Ippan*) or at a mass vaccination site

When you want to make an appointment at a mass vaccination site, please have your vaccination voucher ready and inquire with the Chiba City Coronavirus Vaccine Call Center, or make an appointment at the Chiba City Vaccination Reservation website.

(4) The vaccine types for the third dose

Either Pfizer or Moderna is used regardless of the type of vaccine given for your primary vaccination.

 - ① Reservations: Available only to people who have a family doctor at the hospital
 - ② Vaccine: Moderna
- (3) いちりつかいひんびょういん 市立海浜病院 Chiba Kaihin Municipal Hospital (Isobe, Mihama-ku)
 - ① Reservations: Available only to people who have a family doctor at the hospital
 - ② Vaccine: Pfizer, Moderna
- (4) けんみん ほけんよぼうざいだん そうごうけんしん ちば県民 保健予防財団 総合健診センター
Chiba Foundation for Health Promotion & Disease Control
(Shinminato, Mihama-ku)
 - ① Reservations: Available to anyone
 - ② Vaccine: Pfizer, Moderna

6. Mass Vaccination Site Set Up by Chiba City

In addition to individual vaccinations, Chiba City has opened vaccination sites at public facilities in the city.

- (1) Chiba Chuo Community Center 6th floor
 - ① Date: Sunday 9:00-17:00 (vaccine for 640 people/day)
M-F 18:00-21:00 (vaccine for 240 people/day)
 - ② Setup date: Already setup
 - ③ Vaccine: Pfizer
- (2) Hanamigawa Health and Welfare Center 2nd floor
 - ① Date: Saturdays & Sundays 10:00-17:00 (vaccine for 320 people/day)
 - ② Setup date: Already setup
 - ③ Vaccine: Pfizer in January and Moderna in February
- (3) ICOAS Chishirodai 2nd floor
 - ① Date: Every day 10:30-18:30 (vaccine for 800 people/day)
 - ② Setup date: Already setup
 - ③ Vaccine: Pfizer in January and Moderna in February

(4) AEON Mall Makuhari New City Grand Mall 2nd floor AEON Lounge

① Date: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday to Sunday 10:30-19:30

(vaccine for 400 people/day)

② Setup date: Already setup

③ Vaccine: Pfizer in January and Moderna in February

(5) Soga Community Center 4th floor

① Date: Tuesday to Sunday 10:00-19:00 (vaccine for 720 people/day)

② Setup date: From Friday, February 4

③ Vaccine: Moderna

(6) One's Mall 3rd floor 【temporary】 (330-50 Naganuma-cho, Inage-ku)

① Date: Monday to Wednesday, Friday to Sunday 10:30-19:30

(vaccine for 800 people /day)

② Setup date: Tuesday, February 1

③ Vaccine: Moderna
