COVID-19 Related Information

★Get correct information about

COVID-19 vaccines!

In Japan, the benefits of the vaccine outweigh the concerns of its possible side-effects, and it is thus

recommended you get vaccinated.

① Why get vaccinated?

The vaccine helps prevent you from getting COVID-19. If you do get

COVID-19 after the vaccine, the symptoms will likely be mild. Search for 厚労省 コロナ ワクチ

- ("Ministry of health, labor, and welfare corona vaccine") for more information.
- ② The vaccine is not mandatory

Decide for yourself if you want to get it or not. Remember it is not right to discriminate against those who do or those who don't get vaccinated.

- ③ On the day of your vaccination (before you go the vaccination venue), please check your health. Wear clothes that allow you to easily show your shoulder. Those 15 years old or younger must be accompanied by their guardian.
- ④ Side-effects after getting vaccinated Side-effects may occur after getting the vaccine. The vaccination venue has medicine prepared in case of anaphylaxis (a strong allergic reaction right after getting a vaccine). Fevers and soreness will go away after a few days.

★You must make a reservation for the COVID-19 vaccine

★Please keep your vaccine voucher safe even after your COVID-19 vaccination

Your vaccine voucher is needed to make vaccine reservations, needed on the day of your vaccination, and can also serve as proof of your vaccination. You will also need it to get a Certificate of Vaccination (vaccine passport) if you want to go abroad.

第3子以降の学校給食費が無償化 School Lunch Fees Free of Charge From 3rd Child and Onwards

If your children are attending a municipal elementary or junior high school, school lunches become free from the third child and onward.

Eligibility: people who meet all conditions ①-④

- ① Raising 3 or more children
- ② Paying school lunch fees for the 3rd child and onwards
- ③ Not receiving welfare or using the support

system for school related expenses

Support System for School Related Expenses

You can receive financial support from the city for school related expenses such as your child's school supplies, lunch money, etc.

Eligibility: People who have a child attending a municipal elementary/junior high school, and who meet at least one of the following.

- 1 People who don't have to pay inhabitant tax
- ② People who were receiving welfare before but not receiving it at the time of applying
- ③ People who don't have to pay/are paying reduced national pension premiums or national health insurance premiums
- 4 People receiving child support allowance
- ⑤ People in financial difficulty with special reasons

Apply: Talk to the school your child is attending, write down the necessary information on the application form, and submit it to the school Search 主读市 就学援助 ("Chiba City support for school related expenses") for more details or enquire below.

Municipal Housing Recruiting Residents

Things We can Do before Disasters Happen

We never know when disasters such as earthquakes and heavy rains will strike. In order to minimize damage, it is important to prepare in advance.

① Check Hazard Map

You can use the hazard map to check where there is a risk of disaster and where to evacuate to. For more information, please search for 上京 ("Chiba City hazard map") or ask questions.

② Install an Earthquake-Sensitive Breaker Electricity is the cause of about 60% of fires caused by major earthquakes. Seismic breakers automatically shut off electricity in the event of an earthquake to prevent fires. For more information, search for 草葉市 意識プレーカー ("Chiba City seismic breaker") or ask questions.

③ Prepare Emergency Stockpiles and Items to Take with You

Create a checklist of emergency supplies. Make a checklist of foodstuffs, drinking water, daily necessities, lighting and communication equipment. Make a checklist of emergency items

to be carried. Valuables (cash, health insurance card, cash card, bankbook, etc.), clothing, etc.

- ④ Consider Evacuating Separately
 In order to prevent infectious diseases, it is not
 advisable for many people to gather in one place.
 In addition to designated evacuation centers, such
 as schools and community centers, consider
 evacuating to the home of a friend or staying in
 your home if it's in a safe place.
- ⑤ Prevent Furniture from Tipping over or Falling

Please make sure to secure large pieces of furniture and electrical products not to fall over or fall down during an earthquake.
