National Population Census Announcement

The national population census is a very important survey held once in 5 years, to determine the actual population and household count in the country. All residents of Japan regardless of the nationality are asked to participate in this survey. You may also use the internet to participate.

- ① Until Sat., Sept. 12, an internet downloadable guide will be sent to households. Please answer the survey questions via the internet by Sunday, Sept. 20. Just follow the easy-to-follow instructions on the screen.
- 2 Households failed to participate in the internet survey procedure will be sent a different set of guidelines by mid of September. Fill-out the documents and send it back via mail by Wednesday, Oct. 7 to complete your participation.
- ★ Your data will be kept confidential, but if you have noticed false behavior of the surveyor, or receiving unusual call, report it via telephone.

Be Prepared for Disasters!

Disasters such as earthquake and heavy rain may occur anytime. Early preparation is crucial to minimize damages.

★ Furniture and fixtures are securely fixed to avoid from falling

- use metal fittings to prevent furniture from falling
- think about the direction and place that furniture may fall over when placing it in a room. (Don't place furniture in bedrooms or children's rooms.)
- don't place objects on top of furniture
- when storing items, place heavy ones at the bottom to stabilize it
- place safety film on tableware cabinets and windows to prevent glass from breaking and shattering.

★ Buy new provisions to replenish what you have used

Prepare at least 3-days worth of drinking supplies and food or one-week worth at best. It is also good idea to buy extra supplies that will last a long time.

★ Stay calm, don't panic When a disaster occurs. a possibility of the trains stop, people get stranded, and

cut off.

- check traffic information
- ★ Prepare to ensure returning home on foot safe
 - Portable radio, maps, etc.
 - Ready water, food, and comfortable shoes at work place
 - Know in advance route back home and disaster support station on your way.
 Convenience stores and gas station with this mark can help provide toilet, drinking water, information, etc. during disaster.

★ Emergency Messaging Service 'Saigaiyo Dengon Dial'

The emergency messaging service is available to check the safety of love ones. There are other messaging services available in the internet.

'My number' is a 12-digit individual number to be issued to all registered residents of Japan. This will be used to identify individuals for social security, taxation, disaster prevention, etc. Starting January next year, the system will also be used to apply for many welfare services such as application for child allowance, etc. The card will be sent to you starting October. Make sure to keep it with you.
