# Issuance of the My Number System's Individual Number Card Starts

The Individual Number Card will be issued to you when you apply for one at ward's office. The individual number notification card that was sent to you last year cannot be use as it is. You need to apply if you wish to receive the Individual Number Card

#### Application procedure

## ★ via post office

Fill-out with necessary information the application form sent to you together with the individual number



notification, affix a photograph, and send using the attached envelope. Write down your name and birth date at the back of the picture. Please refer to the enclosed pamphlet for more details.

★ via ward office and other application counters Fill-out the application form to apply. Bring an ID (Resident Card, Driver's License, etc.), photograph, and your individual number notification card when applying. Ask the nearest ward's Citizen's Affairs Division for details, or check the city's

homepage.

Avoid Infectious Diseases when Travel Abroad

Please take the following precautions when travel abroad to avoid infectious diseases such as dysentery, typhoid, cholera, polio, rabies, malaria, middle east respiratory syndrome (MERS), dengue fever, bird flu, etc. especially those traveling to tropical countries such as Africa.

#### <Prior to departure>

★ Check the Quarantine Office's homepage 'FORTH' for information about infectious diseases of the country of your destination

#### <While abroad>

- ★ Avoid consumption of raw or tap water and drinks with ice. Promptly see a local doctor if exhibit symptoms of diarrhea, rash, fever, etc.
- ★ Stay away from live animals particularly chickens, ducks, and dogs.
- ★ Avoid infections from insect bites.

#### <Upon arrival in Japan>

★ Make sure to consult the Quarantine Office if you are suffering from fever, diarrhea, etc.

#### <After return to Japan>

★ Some infections take sometimes for symptoms to occur. Promptly see a doctor if you exhibit symptoms and inform them about the details of your trip.
