Be Prepared for the Disasters

\star Think before you act, when disaster occurs.

- ① Protect yourself and confirm your family's safety.
- ② Gather information about public transportations.

At the time of disaster, there is a possibility that many difficult situations may occur, such as unable to go home due to suspension of public transportation, unable to contact your family and friends, etc. Remain calm when you take action.

\star Make yourself familiar with how you walk back home safely in emergency situation.

 Find out the route to your home and check the location of 'disaster support station' with this symbol, which is usually convenience store and gas



station. These locations will provide water, rest room, and public transportation information.

- ② Carry portable radio, map, cellphone, and portable battery at all time.
- ③ Have your walking shoes, water, flashlight, etc. ready at work.

The coupon, which offers free service for the first time users of 'Angel Helper' service of helping out housework and child-care, has been distributed. You will receive the coupon with mother-child health record book.

★Angel Helper Dispatching Service Eligibility:

-Pregnant woman or someone gave birth within 6 months (Within 12 months, in case of multiple birth)

-Resides in Chiba City.

-Do not have anybody to support housework and child-care during the day.

Contents:

-Support of housework (preparation for meals/ cleaning after meals/doing laundry/cleaning and straighten up room/grocery shopping) -Support of child-care (feeding/changing diaper/bathing support)

The limit for service usage:

2 hours/service, twice a day, total of 20 times (With multiple birth, limit is 50 times)

Cost: First time is free.

クローズアップ モノレール

<u>Close-up: Monorail</u> Learn about the Chiba Monorail. This March marks 30 years since the monorail began running, and during that time there have been



zero train-related casualties. There are two different types of monorail: one runs on top of the tracks, and the other hangs from the tracks. The Chiba monorail hangs from the tracks, and its 15.2km make it the longest monorail of its kind in the world. It has been listed in the Guinness Book of World Records since 2001.

- ★Pneumococcus vaccine for seniors When: Until March 31 next year Eligibility: Anyone who falls under ① - ④ below, and has never had the pneumococcus vaccine before.
 - ① Born between April 2, 1953 and April 1, 1954

- ② Born between April 2, 1948 and April 1, 1949
- \bigcirc Born before April 1, 1944
- ④ Older than 60 and have problems with heart, kidneys, respiratory system, etc.

★Influenza vaccine for seniors When: Mon. Oct. 1 - Mon. Dec. 31 Eligibility:

DPeople who will h



①People who will be 65 or older on the day of the vaccination

2 People between 60 - 64 years old with a disability

Cost: ¥1,800

People who are receiving public assistance or belong to households that are exempt from municipal residence tax (per capita) can get both of these vaccinations free.
