Designated Bicycle Parking Spots

Chiba City is accepting parking spot applications for bicycles and scooters/mopeds (under 50cc). Some parking areas are also taking applications for mid-size motorcycles (51 - 125cc).

Period of Use: April 2019 - March 2020

November is Animal Risk Prevention Month:

Follow the Rules of Pet Care

It's important that we understand animals' nature and behavior for humans and animals to live together peacefully. Please follow guidelines such as don't suddenly draw near/touch an animal, shock an animal, or do things that animal would not like.

★To Dog Owners:

- ① Do not let your dog run freely outside without a leash. It's very dangerous because sometimes when people unleash their dogs in parks or on the street, they might bite or injure people. When you take your dog for a walk, make sure to keep them on the leash.
- ② If your dog bites someone, please contact the Animal Protection and Guidance Center immediately.
- ③ Please register your dog and get it vaccinated for rabies once a year. Please attach the license tag and rabies vaccination tag to their collars.

★To Cat Owners:

Please keep your cats indoors.

Cats can cause problems by defecating in other people's yards, getting into trash, etc.

They can also get into traffic accidents or catch an illness from other cats if they go outside.

感染性胃腸炎や食中毒に注意! Beware of Infectious Gastroenteritis and Food Poisoning caused by a Norovirus!

From autumn to spring, there are many cases of infectious gastroenteritis and food poisoning caused by norovirus. Please be careful not to fall

To Avoid Illness:

- ★Use a disposable mask and/or plastic gloves when you clean up the vomit or excrement. After wiping the area clean, immediately disinfect. Chlorinated disinfectants (calcium hypochlorite) are effective. After cleaning the mess, wash your hands under running water with well-lathered soap.
- ★Properly wash your hands after using the restroom, before meals, and when preparing food; and use a clean towel.
- ★People who prepare food must avoid directly touching the food if they have symptoms such as nausea, diarrhea, and/or a fever.
- ★Eat bivalve shellfish such as oysters only after cooking properly (heat for 90 seconds or longer at 85 - 95°C)

11月は乳幼児突然死症。候群(SIDS)対策強化月間 睡眠中の赤ちゃんの死亡を減らしましょう November is Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) Prevention Month: Reduce the Number of Infants who Die in their Sleep

SIDS is an illness that causes infants to suddenly die with no discernible cause. However, there is data to suggest that following these 3 rules can help prevent SIDS:

- ① Have them sleep on their backs until they are at least 1 year old.
- ② Raise them on breastmilk as much as possible.
- ③ Do not smoke cigarettes.
