### Things You Can Do Before a Disaster Comes

It is important to be prepared for unexpected disasters such as earthquake and heavy rains, to minimize the damage.

### Prepare yourself

★ Prevent your furniture from tipping over or falling down.

Use metal fixtures to secure your large furniture or home electric appliances to prevent them from falling.

★ Have a rotating stock of emergency food (Top-up regularly)

Stock extra foods with a long shelf life in bulk and always replace whatever you eat.

★Register for ちばし愛全・愛心メール (Chiba City Safe and Secure Mail)

Receive important information for crime and disaster prevention by email. Search ちばし 愛全・安心メール for more information such as registration method

- ★When a disaster occurs
- ① Ensure you and your family are safe.
- ② Verify traffic conditions.
- ★On a daily basis, think of a way to walk home safely in case of disasters.
- ① Check your route back home and the disaster support station. Convenience stores and restaurants

people walking home by providing water, restroom, and traffic information in case of disasters.

- ② Bring a map and a portable battery for your cellphone.
- ③ Keep water and comfortable shoes at work.

In Chiba City, various scams have occurred using the telephone, such as 'it's me scam' (bank transfer scam), refund scam, etc. Protect yourself by understanding specific methods of scammers.

- ★How to avoid phone scams
- ① Do not answer calls from an unknown number.
- ② Do not make a judgement for yourself, consult your family or police when you feel the call is suspicious.

② Limited Term (for households with children)
Application Requirements: In addition to the requirements in ①, you must be a household that has only parents under 45 years old and children in and under elementary school age.

Scheduled Move-in Day: After January 1, 2020

Lottery Date: Thursday, October 31

Application Form: Forms will be distributed starting from Wednesday, September 25 at the Chiba City Housing Supply Corporation, the Community Promotion Division of each Ward Office, and the Prefectural Housing Information Plaza (中央区業 町 1-16, 1-16 Sakae-cho, Chuo-ku)

# Health and Consultations

結核は早期発見が大切です

Catch Tuberculosis Early

Tuesday, September 24-Monday, September 30 is

Tuberculosis Prevention Week.

Tuberculosis is not an illness of the past. Many people nowadays are still becoming infected. You can prevent it spreading to people around you by finding and treating it early. Tuberculosis can be treated without hospitalization.

#### **★**What is tuberculosis?

Tuberculosis is an illness that occurs when someone comes into contact with tuberculosis bacteria in the air from an infected person's cough or sneeze.

### ★Go to the hospital if these symptoms appear

- (1) Coughing/phlegm continue for more than two weeks
- ② Fatigue and dizziness continue for a long time
- ③ No appetite
- 4 A fever continues for a long time
- ⑤ Sudden loss of body weight

### **★**To prevent tuberculosis

- ① Get enough sleep
- ② Exercise
- ③ Don't smoke cigarettes
- 4 Eat a balanced diet



# ★ Get a periodical health exam so you can find it

Please get a health examination once a year through your company, etc. that includes a chest x-ray. Those aged 65 or over can get a tuberculosis exam and lung cancer inspection for free (the health check-up tickets have been mailed out in May). It's also very bad if infants catch it. The tuberculosis check is done at the same time as the 4-month health check-up; please be sure to get the BCG prevention vaccine.
