


# Requests from the Municipal Government to the Residents (Apr. 14)


Please continue to follow basic infection prevention measures while avoiding "the three C's".

No loud voices No sharing



If you feel even just a little unwell, e.g. fever or tiredness, please refrain from going out and visit a medical institution after consulting by phone in advance.




# Changes in the official tallies of infected patients in Chiba City, in terms of the actual daily number on the day of announcement (7-day average)






## Current Status of Newly Infected Patients in the City (Date of announcement)
