Information about COVID-19 Vaccination (July 7)



1. Please consider the 4th vaccination. New cases of infections are increasing in the city!

The fourth vaccination is expected to have these effects

☆ Preventive effect for severe disease



Elderly peoplePersons with underlying conditions

Those at high risk of serious illness

What about side effects?

☆ Minor side effects (headache, muscle pain, etc.) may occur, but no serious side effects (such as permanent disability) have been observed so far.)

OThere are still slots available for reservations at the vaccination venues, so **please consider getting vaccination as soon as possible** if you are eligible. OThe 1st, 2nd, and 3rd vaccinations are also available. If you have not been vaccinated yet, please consider it!

3. Vaccination venue (common to aged 12 & over)

- (1) Individual medical institutions : approx. 300 venues (Please contact the Vaccine Call Center.)
- (2) Mass vaccinations: as per the chart at right

The 4^{th} vaccination voucher is sent to all persons 18 years of age and older who have received the 3^{rd} vaccination so that eligible persons can receive the 4th vaccination as soon as possible.

Even if you receive a vaccination voucher, those who are not eligible can not receive the vaccination.

Please be sure to check if you are eligible before making a reservation.

60 years of age or older

18-59 years old and meet one of the following

- Those who have underlying conditions (for details, please refer to the document enclosed with the vaccination voucher.)
- Obese person with a BMI (weight in kg/height in m/height in m) is 30 or more.
- Those who are considered by the physician to be at high risk of serious illness

Request from the Municipal Government to the Residents (July 7)



The number of new infections has begun to increase, and the 7-day average of new infections per day has increased by about 30% compared to last week. Please continue to take thorough measures to prevent infection.

- ✓ Please refrain from going to crowded places or places where the risk of infection is high.
- ✓ Refrain from going to work, school and travelling when feeling ill.
- If you are elderly or have underlying conditions, please make efforts to reduce risks for infection, such as meeting in person with a few familiar people.
- Wear a mask when meeting the elderly or going to the hospitals.
- For those who have not been vaccinated up to the third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and those who are eligible for the fourth dose, please consider early vaccination.
- If you feel even slightly unwell, such as a fever or malaise, refrain from going out and seek medical attention after consulting with a medical institution by phone beforehand.
